- Some felt encouraged about young people's turnout.
- First Gen Z candidate made it into Congress.
  - o We need to encourage them and understand their issues better.
- Some were discouraged that we did not hold the House.
- PA was a big win up and down the ticket.
- We will not have a referendum on abortion because we are holding the Senate.
- People in Europe are heartened for us, breathing a sigh of relief.
- Hope that Garland will finally indict.
- Jacobin article: good article on the importance of Democrats addressing the needs of multiracial working class voters as concerns the successful election results.

- Fetterman's win is important: Biden is moving away from neo-liberal austerity.
- Student debt, climate, and union organizing are key issues that are drawing young people
- It does not look that great in the US: Ohio, Wisconsin, Missouri were either blue or swing states, and have turned red.
- Lessons:
  - o We cannot listen to the polls and the media; media engaged in malpractice. Tune it out.
  - o Races are getting tougher and tougher. The swing is tiny.
  - o Dem. messaging needs to be much better.

- What would it be like if we had no gerrymanders?
- Mis-information that people are getting that they are voting on is terrible.
- A young RaR member spoke: Many young people did not vote, which was difficult.
  Pleasantly surprised about overall results.

- State Dem leadership crushed the Working Families Party, kneecapped a Dem primary winner to get their people in.
- Jay Jacobs head of the State Committee. His corruption and the corruption of the State Committee is publicly exposed at national level.
  - o There may be a shake-up at the State level.
  - o Jay Jacobs has to go, structure of State Committee
- Messaging: Dems pass bail reform and their support is tepid.

- Zeldin is very much a danger; very energetic on twitter.
- Hochul's lackluster campaign is a problem, and she has a corruption problem.
- Mayor Adams Republican playbook; he is a big problem.
  - o We must critique everything he has done, argue against his use of violence, his BS about bail support.
- Christina Gonzalez made it b/c of young people's support.
- Robert: NY Dems office near the Stock Exchange. Should we do a Clean House action on their own turf?
- Livvie: A web has been developing WFP, Indivisibles, DSA. This network has provided an alternative to State Committee
- Livvie: Regarding RaR's commitment to the Max Rose/Malliotokis campaign
  - o We had a lot of conversations, we stayed with it. We were combatting MAGA where it raises its ugly head.
  - o We have made alliances with a lot of new groups in Brooklyn and Staten Island.
