1/3/23-- NYPAN Press Conference and Update on Jay Jacobs and the New York State Democratic Party and

160 gathered on a zoom call on Monday night December 19—wide range of folks who want to get rid of Jay Jacobs. The group is moving ahead. Committees are forming to investigate various aspects of what it would take. George Santos' fraud has been revealed. We could use this to revive our Democratic Party structure. WI and NV party structures might be good models for NY.

Jan. 3--NYPAN Press Conference. Would be good to have signs for the press conference. Reserved City Hall steps.

PRESS CONFERENCE ENDORSED

1/6/23--INDICT action--1PM at NYPL steps (similar to last year's action).

Decided to do a tableau on the steps of the NYPL. 24 by 36 indict signs. Will include Scott Perry, Navarro, Bannon etc. Will have as many of our large banners as we have people to hold them. We may be the only action that day. Trying to have a large crowd that day.

Truck update: In the works and it will be good per Rick. There will be text and video footage and 14th amendment info and will reflect what we are doing on the ground. This will be a video truck. Creating a 1-1/2 min video about the coup plotters with graphics, images, clips from the insurrection etc. We will be able to move the truck from the library and can drive it to other locations such as Trump Tower etc. We have the truck for 8 hours. Bklyn wants to know if we could bring it to Schumer's house, but we want to map out a route for the truck. Rise and Resist will be in the credits at the end.

QR code was suggested. Idea: Include the 4 charges from the Jan. 6 committee.

Maybe 4 large signs for the action with each of the charges.
There will be a Facebook page for this event which will go up tomorrow.

Action Committee report back on NYYRC Gala - what we would do differently in retrospect

Two things could have done differently

We should have taken a step back altogether and retreated and talked about what we wanted to do. Instead, we just started to do things.

We should have taken a bust. We should have stood in front of the doors, held our signs, waited for the warnings. We weren't prepared for CD but we might have gone ahead had we talked about it at the moment. Next time we go to something like this, we should be prepared to get arrested. Jackie suggested maybe we need a refresher on CD because we may need it. We need to be ready to stand our ground.

We also didn't have a designated photographer.

No one covered what happened there. NY Times didn't assign a report or photographer. It wasn't in the paper until it appeared on social media. The media coverage centered on the Southern Poverty Law Center's focus. The reporters went inside very early so no one was outside. Maybe we send a press release to our known media sources next time. Might be worthwhile to contact the SPLC so next time, we have some communication and coordination with them. We need a dedicated person to talk to SPLC. Donna volunteered to talk to SPLC.

A group of haters showed up on Saturday at a drag story hour in a library in Chelsea. Eric Bottcher was at the story hour since it's in his district. The haters engaged with him and posted it on his Instagram. Yesterday they went to his office, tried to get in, yelled outside his office and then they vandalized the hallway outside the building. Two hours later, they got Eric's personal phone # and left horrific messages on his phone; showed up at his apt building, screamed at him, called him a groomer, pedophile etc. Two of the women involved have been arrested. Crowd started to disperse after they were arrested.

What would be good would be to investigate the Drag Storytelling events all over the City. They need our support.

Need a message that can appeal to more people. "Just haters" doesn't do it. There is a 1000+ organized group called Far Right Conspiracy Theorists.

Messaging—protect children from hate mongering.

Could this be included in a communication to SPLC by Donna

All needs to be contextualized against the bigger story which is what's going on with the LGBTQ community all over the world.

We need to view the Republicans as groomers of hatred and violence.

REPORT BACKS

12/15--Rikers Vigil--Thursday Dec 15 at 5 pm in Times Sq. Subway Station near Shuttle. Went to the Times Sq subway station in the shuttle area. Had about 18 people.

Arranged ourselves differently this time, signs on the side of the banner rather than behind. Lots of people rushed by. We gave out 300 flyers. Ray loved the space and hearing the Spanish ballads, New Yorkers rushing back and forth.

Not a classically good space because people were walking fast but this space really felt like NYC. Didn't expect as many people to be sympathetic.

There were 5 police there initially and they came up and said they agreed with us. Two people came in the middle from Freedom Agenda to support us and stayed until the end.

12/16--Say Their Names canceled due to rain - every Friday at 4:30PM No Say Their Names on Friday, December 23 or 30. Next meeting is the first Friday in January, Jan. 6.

12/18—Immigration Action--Sunday Dec 18 at 12:15 58th St./5th Ave. - Mary and Joseph were Seeking Asylum- Immigration Action

We started at the Plaza Fountain and walked down to the Cathedral. We paused from time to time and assembled ourselves. People paid a lot of attention and took lots of pictures. Weather was good and the street was closed. When we got to St. Pat's and mass was ending, we turned around and faced the Cathedral so the people pouring out could see the banners and signs. It was a great move to be in front as people came out of mass. People were really surprised and took a lot of pictures. Next time we should have some kind of beat or music. The open Fifth Avenue worked well for us. We could take up the whole street and be very visible. Next year maybe just try to set up at St. Pat's.

12/19--ARREST TRUMP Lights Monday Dec 19 at 4:30 pm at Trump Tower Had quite a few people. Some people with signs in front of the building. Others holding the lights(which spelled out ARREST TRUMP) next to the street behind the cement barrier. Tons of positive reactions; a few negatives. It was cold. People were taking tons of photos from across the street. The timing of this action made it particularly exciting to be part of. It was a bit dangerous for the photographers running into the street. We might want to have someone dedicated to watching the traffic. Needed a couple of marshals watching the cars and wearing reflective vests. Lots of tourists posed with the smaller signs. We might want to have a QR code

with a hashtag so people can access more information.

12/20 Truth Tuesday at FOX "News" every Tuesday at 12 noon

Lot of negative reactions today. A few guys poured water over Kim's chalk and were working to erase the messages and they wouldn't go away. We occupied them with the chalk to distract them so they wouldn't make more trouble.
